Applies to evanvandoren.com. The Terms & Conditions for Adaptable Arrangements and Custom Arrangements are separate documents that apply only to clients under a signed Quote.

These terms cover your use of evanvandoren.com. They're short on purpose. By using the site, you agree to them. If you don't, please don't use the site, and feel free to email me with questions first.

1 Who I Am and Who This Site Is For

This site is run by VanDoren Music LLC, owned and operated by Evan VanDoren ("I," "me," "VanDoren Music"), a Texas company. It describes my marching band arrangements, shows, and resources, and it's written for band directors, educators, and program staff.

2 Nothing on This Site Is an Offer

Prices, availability, timelines, package contents, and exclusivity described on this site are for information only, and they can change. Working together starts with a Quote or Invoice from me, and the Terms & Conditions for Adaptable Arrangements or Custom Arrangements that come with it govern the work. If anything on this site conflicts with a Quote or those Terms & Conditions, the Quote and Terms & Conditions control.

Contacting me doesn't create a client relationship or obligate either of us to anything.

3 Contacting Me

You can reach me through the contact form, email, or a scheduling link. I'll use what you send to respond and follow up, as described in the Privacy Policy in Part Two of this document. Please give accurate information, and don't send student personal information or payment details through the site. I'll never ask for them this way.

4 Site Content and Ownership

The music, scores, audio, video, text, images, logos, and design on this site belong to VanDoren Music LLC or are used with permission. "VanDoren Music," "Evan VanDoren," and my logo are my marks.

You're welcome to view the site, listen to samples, and share links to it. You may not copy, reproduce, record, distribute, perform, adapt, or build on anything from the site without my written permission, and you may not scrape the site or use its content to train machine learning models.

5 Samples and Previews

Sample scores, audio, videos, and show clips are here so you can evaluate my work. Seeing or hearing an arrangement isn't a license to perform it, rehearse from it, record it, or arrange it yourself. Performing an arrangement requires a purchase under a signed agreement and the copyright license for the underlying music.

Many of my arrangements are based on music owned by other people. I name composers, publishers, ensembles, and shows to describe what an arrangement is based on. That doesn't mean I'm affiliated with or endorsed by any of them.

Obtaining copyright permission to perform an arrangement is the responsibility of the band program. I offer licensing help as a paid service, and how that works is set out in the Quote and Terms & Conditions. If a show is based on someone else's visual design, the original designers may hold rights of their own.

7 Free Downloads and Resources

Guides, cards, and other downloads offered on this site are licensed to you, not sold. You may use them for your own band program and share them with your own program's staff. You may not sell them, post them elsewhere, publish them, or give the files to other programs or third parties. You're welcome to share a link to the page where you found them.

Downloads are educational and provided as they are, with no guarantee of results. I may update or remove them at any time. If you buy the Woodwind and Brass Fundamentals Package, it's governed by the Terms & Conditions that come with your Quote, not by this section.

Part Two — Website Privacy Policy

THE SHORT VERSION

I collect what you send me when you reach out, plus basic visit data so I can see how the site is used. I use it to answer you and run my business. I don't sell it, but I do use Google Ads, which means some visit data is used to show you my ads on other sites. You can ask me to correct or delete what I have, or stop emailing you, at any time.

1 Who I Am

This site is run by VanDoren Music LLC, owned and operated by Evan VanDoren ("I," "me"), a Texas company. You can reach me at evanvandoren@gmail.com. This policy covers evanvandoren.com. The site is meant for band directors, educators, and program staff in the United States.

2 What I Collect

What you give me. When you fill out a contact form, book a call, or email me, I collect your name, email address, school or program, city and state, what you're interested in, how you heard about me, and anything you write in your message. If you give me a phone number, I collect that too. If we go on to work together, I collect the project details you send me, such as show information and repertoire ideas.

What the site collects automatically. Like most sites, this one records technical information when you visit: your IP address, browser and device type, the pages you view, and how you arrived. I use Google Analytics to see which pages get visited, and Google Ads to measure whether my ads lead to visits and to show my ads to people who have visited the site. Both use cookies or similar technology to do this.

I don't ask for and don't want student personal information, payment card numbers, or government ID numbers through this site. Please don't send them.

3 How I Use It

I use your information to respond to your inquiry, schedule calls, prepare quotes, and carry out projects. I also use it to send follow-up emails, including a short series of messages about my services if you've inquired and haven't yet worked with me. Every one of those emails has an unsubscribe link, and you can also just tell me to stop.

I use visit data to improve the site, and I may use information to protect my business, meet legal and tax obligations, or enforce my agreements.

4 Who I Share It With

I don't sell your personal information for money. I do use Google Ads, and the advertising tags on this site let Google recognize your browser after you visit and show you my ads on other sites. Some state privacy laws treat that as "sharing" personal information for targeted advertising. Section 5 explains how to opt out.

I do use other companies to run the business, and they handle your information on my behalf. They include providers of website hosting, forms and contact management, scheduling, email, project tracking, file storage, analytics, and tools that help me draft and organize project materials, including AI tools. They may use your information only to provide their services to me.

I may also disclose information if the law requires it, or if I sell or restructure the business, in which case the information would go to the new owner under this policy.

5 Cookies and Do Not Track

Cookies are small files a site stores in your browser. Google Analytics uses them to count visits and see which pages are read, and Google Ads uses them to measure and target my ads. You can block or delete cookies in your browser settings, and the site will still work.

To opt out of ad targeting, use Google's Ads Settings at adssettings.google.com. To opt out of Google Analytics, install Google's browser add-on at tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout. Browsers also offer a "Do Not Track" setting. There's no common standard for it, and this site doesn't respond to those signals.

6 How Long I Keep It

I keep inquiry and project information as long as I need it to respond, do the work, and meet legal and tax obligations. I don't keep it longer than that without a reason. If you want yours deleted sooner, ask.

7 Your Choices

Wherever you live, you can email me to see what I have about you, correct it, delete it, or stop receiving my emails. I'll respond within 45 days. I may need to confirm it's you first, and I may have to keep some records, such as those of a signed agreement, for legal or tax reasons. If you're in a state with its own privacy law, these are the same requests that law gives you, and I'll treat them the same way.

8 Security

I use reasonable measures to protect your information, and the companies I rely on do the same. No method of sending or storing information is completely secure, so I can't promise it never will be breached.

9 Children

This site is for adults who work in education. It isn't directed to children under 13, and I don't knowingly collect their information. If a child has sent me something, email me and I'll delete it.

10 Other Sites

This site links to and embeds services I don't control, such as video hosting and scheduling. Their privacy practices are their own, so read their policies before you share anything there.
